Prof. Federiga Bindi is Jean Monnet Chair at the University of Rome Tor Vergata, where she was also the founding director of the EU Center of Excellence. Prof. Bindi has been a visiting fellow in several institutions, including the *Institute for Women's Policy Research*, the *Brookings Institution, Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, Sciences Po* in Paris, the *Norwegian Institute of International Affairs*, the *University of Lisbon*, and the *Université Libre de Bruxelles*.

Dr. Bindi held several policy appointments in government, including serving Senior Advisor to Italian Foreign Minister Franco Frattini, and Fellow in the U.S. Senate Foreign Relations Committee under Sen. John Kerry's chairmanship. She also led the international affairs department at the Italian National School of Administration and served as director of the Italian Cultural Institute in Brussels.
